**KCare** aims to provide opportunities for children to develop confidence in communicating with others, social skills, self-help skills and values such as responsibility, care and respect.

#### **PROGRAMME**

#### How do I apply?



Application forms are available at the KCare centre



Parents are required to return the completed form to MOE through your child's KCare centre



MOE will inform you of the application outcome through your KCare centre

Note: KCare Additional Subsidy is <u>administered by MOE</u>. This is provided in addition to the Basic Subsidy. It is meant to provide additional financial support for Singaporean children who are enrolled in our KCare and household income meets the income criteria.

What should I do if there is a change in my household financial circumstances or working status?



You should re-submit your KCare Additional Subsidy application to MOE through **your child's KCare centre** as soon as possible



Should you need to extend the period of the Additional Subsidy, please <u>submit a new</u> application to MOE through the KCare centre, with updated supporting documents
